Fresh Water Half Day Experience

Eco Explorer Camp

Enjoy a laughter-filled week of games and mischief that includes stand-up paddle boarding while learning about the importance of sustainability, how to read the weather and tides, how to identify local seabirds, seaweeds and the flora and fauna of the Dingle Peninsula through rock pooling! Geared toward children aged from 10 to 15, this summer camp will give them the confidence to have fun and be safe in the water. Each day includes a slightly different activity paired with SUP ranging from how to make a sail from foraged objects to creating a sup board out of plastic bottles.

Night SUP in a Dark Sky Reserve

Paddle out onto the glassy lake nestled in a valley surrounded by silent mountains, the night sky ablaze with stars above you. The dark sky reserve above the Macgillicuddy Reeks mountains in mid Kerry is the only gold tier reserve in the Northern Hemisphere and this is an opportunity to experience the night sky like our ancestors did, only a whole lot better! Meet in the hidden valley and prepare to launch, a soft light glowing in the water from below the board illuminating the lake water below. After gazing up at the stars, enjoy a hot drink by a warm bonfire on the lake shore.







Stand Up Paddle & Free Camp the Coast of Kenmare Bay

Over the course of three days, paddle the 40 kilometre route from the heart of Kenmare to the lovely little village of Sneem, along the famous Ring of Kerry. This paddle follows the coastline of Kenmare Bay, allowing for exploration of the islands, coves, rivers, and inlets. The sheltered coastline provides perfect paddle conditions and was named by Lonely Planet as one of the top 9 places in the world for a multi-day SUP trip. At night, camp in the wilderness and cook over an open fire. All food is locally sourced and eaten all fresco.

Kenmare Bay: A SUP Adventure Retreat

Paddle the 40 magnificent kilometers from Sneem to Kenmare along the famous Ring of Kerry over the course of four days. Weaving in and out of the coves, islands, bays and rivers, experience chance encounters with wildlife while discovering ruined houses and secret places very few people ever get to see. After a full day of exploring, delight in the comforts of the area's best hotels with nights spent at the 5* Parknasilla Resort and Spa, Sheen Falls Lodge, and others. Fine dining in the evening paired with nights spent at the local pub enjoying traditional music and storytelling make this an unforgettable authentic Irish experience with a twist!


















Wild SUP Tours | General Information

Opening Hours:

- o 9:00 to 20:00 April through October.
- O Tours can be arranged in the winter months, weather permitting.

Premises:

- Located directly behind 'Out Of The Blue' across from Dingle marina.
- On site there are changing facilities and a secure place for guests to store their belongings while out on the water.

Weather Notice:

- Stand up paddle boarding is a weather dependent sport. Sometimes, if conditions are not suitable, a tour must be cancelled, safety is a top priority. In such instances...
 - o Wild SUP Tours aims to reschedule in these cases if at all possible.
 - For the multi day tours, there are contingency plans in place to accommodate for days not spent on the water, such as hiking to hidden waterfalls and historical cultural parks in the area.
 - o **NOTE:** This is not a common occurrence. Tours are **very rarely** cancelled.







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
